

Confirmation Letter to Msgr. Martin

Candidates are to write a one-page letter telling Msgr. Martin why you want to be confirmed, and how you have been preparing for Confirmation. Include what **service projects** you have been a part of and how doing service for others has affected your life and the lives of others. Also, include how you plan to continue your life of service after Confirmation. See format for writing the letter below. **Letter is due the last class before the test (Jan. 21-23).**

Greeting:

Begin your letter with the greeting: **Dear Msgr. Martin,**

Body of Letter:

Paragraph 1: Introduce yourself. Tell something about yourself, your family, and your life.

Paragraph 2: Tell Msgr. what you have been doing to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation and why you want to be confirmed.

Paragraph 3: Tell Msgr. about the service hours you have completed in preparation for Confirmation. What did you do? Where did you complete the service projects? Whom did you help and how? Give at least two examples. Tell about any special experiences you had doing your service, or people that you helped that touched your life.

Conclusion:

Conclude your letter by telling Msgr. Martin how you will continue to serve others after Confirmation.

Then sign your full name in **ink** (pen)!!!!.
